FOOD BANK OF THE ROCKIES RECEIVES \$19,000 DONATION FROM THE DARDEN FOUNDATION

DENVER, CO August 1, 2018—Food Bank of the Rockies announced today a \$19,000 grant from The Darden Foundation to assist in their efforts of providing help to people facing hunger. The generous unrestricted grant will allow the food bank to provide 76,000 meals and allocate funds in areas the community needs the most, such as mobile pantries, fresh produce purchases and food programs for children.

“Food is a must. And for 1 in 10 Coloradans struggling with hunger, food isn’t always available,” said Michelle Barnes, Food Bank of the Rockies’ interim CEO. “Hunger doesn’t discriminate. Worrying about where to find the next meal is even higher among Colorado children; 1 in 6 live in food insecure homes. Nearly half a million people count on our food bank’s programs and partner agencies for help. The Darden Foundation’s donation will go a long way to help these families thrive.”
